REFUND POLICY: Because most fees paid for events are actually spent prior to the event, refunds will be made only under the following conditions: A written request must be received by Council Volunteer Services 14 calendar days before the event. The written request, submitted to Volunteer Services, must be in writing by the person who submitted the original reservation. The only exception is in the case of emergency, injury, or illness. The exception request must be in writing and verified by a parent and/or guardian and a physician. The maximum available refund under this provision will be 50% of the total fee paid by the individual. Cancellation requests received by the required deadline, stated above, will result in a full refund minus a non-refundable, non-transferable fee.
